1 WHEREAS, 2019 Assembly Bill 612, which is proposed state legislation that is set forth in Exhibit A
 2 (2019 Assembly Bill 612), allows a county to enact an ordinance requiring the annual registration of
 3 animal-drawn vehicles that are customarily kept in the county and used for transportation purposes; and

5 WHEREAS, as proposed, the registration fee cannot exceed \$100, the county shall pay 50 percent of the
 6 registration fee to the town in which the animal-drawn vehicle is customarily kept, and the registration fee
 7 must be used for transportation purposes or administrative costs related to the collection of the fees; and

9 WHEREAS, the proposed state legislation would assist law enforcement in identifying owners of animal-
 10 drawn vehicles and enforcement of road safety standards as well as provide funding to improve the
 11 county's roads; and

13 WHEREAS, such proposed state legislation is supported by the Wisconsin Counties Association and the
 14 Wisconsin Town Association.

16 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Clark County Board of Supervisors hereby supports the
 17 creation of state legislation to allow counties to enact an ordinance requiring the registration of animal-
 18 drawn vehicles as set forth in Exhibit A.

 21 Evers, the State Legislators for Clark County, and the Wisconsin Counties Association for consideration.
