8 WHEREAS, the Sawyer County Board of Supervisors supports and commits to
9 promote the availability of telecommuting options;

11 WHEREAS, the Sawyer County Board of Supervisors hereby appoints
12 Tom Hoff as the single point of contact for coordinating telecommuting
13 opportunities within Sawyer County including the following responsibilities:

- 14 1. Coordination and partnership with broadband providers, realtors, economic development
15 professionals, employers, employees, and other telecommuting stakeholders.
16 2. Collaboration with broadband providers and employers to identify, develop, and market
17 telecommuter-capable broadband packages.
18 3. Communication and partnership with broadband providers and economic development
19 professionals to develop common goals.
20 4. Promotion of telecommuter-friendly workspaces, such as business incubators with
21 telecommuting spaces, if such a workspace has been established in the political
22 subdivision at the time the political subdivision adopts the resolution.
23 5. Familiarity with broadband mapping tools and other state-level resources.
24 6. Maintaining regular communication with the state broadband office.
25 7. Making regular reports to the [governing body of the political subdivision].

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY PROCLAIMED by the Sawyer County Board of
28 Supervisors support telecommuting opportunities for Sawyer County in its application for
29 Telecommuter Forward! Community certification


