TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

MAJORITY

1 The State Public Defender's office is an independent, executive-branch state agency that
2 ensures Wisconsin meets its constitutional requirement of providing legal representation
3 to the indigent. The Wisconsin Supreme Court recently made a decision to raise court-
4 appointed public defenders' pay from \$70 to \$100 per hour, however, the state-funded
5 public defenders' pay remains at \$40 per hour. Increasing pay for some lawyers and not
6 others may lead private attorneys to refuse public defender assignments. It is critical
7 that persons in need of a defender get adequate and equal protection and access to an
8 attorney under the law.

10 NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Public Safety Committee recommend
11 adoption of the following resolution.

12 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does go on record in
13 support of a defendant's constitutional right to a fair and speedy trial and representation without
14 infringements on their ability to pay, and


15 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to forward a copy
16 of this resolution to the Outagamie County Lobbyist, Outagamie County District Attorney, Wisconsin
17 Counties Association, and the Outagamie County Executive.




