RESOLUTION NO.: 37—2017-18

TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

MAJORITY

1 Legislation has been introduced by the Wisconsin State Legislature to amend state
2 statutes relating to hours of instructional program required for certified nursing assistants
3 (CNAs). This legislation conforms state law for instructional programs for CNAs to the
4 federal law requirements for Medicare and Medicaid. Specifically, the proposal prohibits
5 the Department of Health Services from requiring an instructional program to exceed the
6 federal required minimum total training hours specified in the federal regulation. Current
7 federal regulation requires 75 hours of training, whereas the state requires 120 hours of
8 classroom instruction and 32 hours of clinical training, making it difficult to train and
9 recruit qualified CNAs. Current state requirements are placing facilities at a disadvantage
10 as neighboring states mirror the federal standard.

13 NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Health and Human Services Committee
14 recommend adoption of the following resolution.

15 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does request that the State
16 of Wisconsin amend state statutes to mirror federal requirements for CNA training, and

17 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to forward a copy
18 of this resolution to the Brewster Village Director, and the Outagamie County Lobbyist for distribution
19 to Governor Walker, the Legislature, and Wisconsin Counties Association.

2017 BILL

1 AN ACT to amend 146.40 (3) of the statutes; relating to: hours of instructional
2 program for nurse aids.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill conforms state law for instructional programs for nurse aides to the federal law requirements for Medicare and Medicaid. Specifically, the bill prohibits the Department of Health Services from requiring an instructional program to exceed the federal required minimum total training hours or minimum hours of supervised practical training, which is clinical experience, specified in the federal regulation. The current federal regulation requires no less than 75 hours of training with at least 16 of those hours being supervised practical training.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 146.40 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 146.40 (3) Except as provided in sub. (4d), the department shall approve
5 instructional programs for nurse aides that apply for, and satisfy standards for,
6 approval that are promulgated by rule by the department. The department may not
7 require an instructional program to exceed the federal required minimum total

SECTION 1

1 training hours or minimum hours of supervised practical training under 42 CFR
2 483.152 (a). The department shall review the curriculum of each approved
3 instructional program at least once every 24 months following the date of approval
4 to determine whether the program continues to satisfy the standards for approval.
5 Under this subsection, the department may, after providing notice, suspend or
6 revoke the approval of an instructional program or impose a plan of correction on the
7 program if the program fails to satisfy the standards for approval or operates under
8 conditions that are other than those contained in the application approved by the
9 department.
