

POPULATION CHANGE: BIRTHS, DEATHS, AND NET MIGRATION




Population Density (Jan 2018 County Estimate)





Population Density (Jan 2018 Minor Civil Division Estimate)




Total Population Change (Apr 2010 to July 2018)




Natural Change (April 2010 to July 2018) $\left(\frac{[births-deaths]}{April 2010 population}\right)$








Numeric Births Change: 2017 Births Minus 1990 Births




Non-Metropolitan Wisconsin Defined




Metropolitan Wisconsin Births and Deaths




Net Migration (April 2010 to July 2018) ([in-movers - out-movers] April 2010 population]











Net Housing Unit Change










Projected Population Change 2015-2035



65-and-Over-Population (as a percent of total population)




Non-Metro 65-and-Over-Population (as a percent of total population)





Wisconsin Labor Force Participation Rates by Age



Non-Metro Population Change 2015-2035




2017 Per Capita Personal Income





2017 Wisconsin Total Personal Income, by Component





WI Total Personal Income Change 2007-2017 (not inflation adj.)





Transfer Receipts as % of Total Personal Income




