TO THE DOOR COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

1 **WHEREAS**, Existing (Wisconsin and federal) law criminalizes the
2 possession and use of cannabis (i.e., tetrahydrocannabinols, commonly
3 known as "THC"); and

4
5 **WHEREAS**, As of November, 2018, the use of cannabis for medical
6 purposes is legal in 33 states; and

7
8 **WHEREAS**, While there is a dearth of rigorous peer-reviewed studies
9 (clinical trials), the relative benefits and risks of medical cannabis are
10 believed to be reasonably well understood; and

11
12 **WHEREAS**, The Door County Board of Supervisors supports
13 Wisconsin taking steps toward cannabis legalization for medical purposes;
14 and

16 **WHEREAS**, These steps would include the research, consideration
17 and development of regulations and rules that will enable persons who are
18 in demonstrated need of cannabis for specified medical purposes to obtain
19 and use cannabis under limited circumstances and address any anticipated
20 negative secondary effects to public health, safety, and welfare; and

22 **WHEREAS**, The legalization of medical cannabis without appropriate
23 rules and regulations could result in the creation of negative secondary
24 effects to public health, safety and welfare.

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, That the Door County Board
27 of Supervisors hereby expresses its support for Wisconsin taking steps
28 toward cannabis legalization for medical purposes.

30 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That the Door County Clerk is directed
31 to provide a copy of this resolution to the all Wisconsin County Clerks, the
32 Wisconsin Counties Association, each state and federal legislator
33 representing Door County, Governor Scott Walker, and Governor-elect
34 Tony Evers.
