- 1 WHEREAS, in July 2010 with Resolution 30-7-10, the Clark County Board of Supervisors supported  
2 delisting the gray wolf to allow for the effective management of the gray wolf population by the  
3 Wisconsin DNR (DNR); and  
4  
5 WHEREAS, although Clark County supported a population goal of 350 wolves in 2010, gray wolf  
6 population has increased to approximately 950 wolves as of April 2019; and  
7  
8 WHEREAS, with the increase in the gray wolf population, Wisconsin residents have experienced  
9 depredation as well as threats to human safety and other animals resulting in reduced hunting  
10 opportunities, and compromised agricultural operations; and  
11  
12 WHEREAS, one management control method the DNR has used to address depredation by wolves is to  
13 relocate problem wolves to other counties in the state; and  
14  
15 WHEREAS, such method has been found to be ineffective in eliminating depredation as these wolves  
16 cause damage after relocation; and  
17  
18 WHEREAS, considering Clark County has a large county forest with many agricultural operations, Clark  
19 County is concerned that the relocation of problem wolves in the county would significantly impact  
20 recreational opportunities and agricultural operations.

22 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Clark County Board of Supervisors hereby opposes the  
23 DNR relocating problem wolves into Clark County from other counties and/or states.  
24  
25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Clerk shall mail copies of this resolution to Governor  
26 Evers, the State Legislators for Clark County, the Secretary of the DNR, and the Wisconsin Counties  
27 Association for consideration.
