2 **DECLARING A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY**

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4 **WHEREAS**, in December, 2019, a novel strain of the coronavirus was detected, now
5 named COVID-19, and it has spread throughout numerous countries including the
6 United States; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, issued a State of
8 Emergency for the State of Wisconsin on March 12, 2020 which expired on May 11,
9 2020; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in order to protect the health and well-being of its residents, the County of
11 Marinette must avail itself of all resources needed to respond to and contain the
12 presence of COVID-19 in the County; and

13 **WHEREAS**, on May 15, 2020, the Chair of the Marinette County Board of Supervisors,
14 John Guarisco, signed a declaration proclaiming since March 12, 2020, a State of
15 Emergency has continuously existed in Marinette County; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the response to and recovery from the COVID-19 public health emergency
17 has imposed economic strain on the resources of the County.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the Marinette County Board of Supervisors
19 affirms and declares a Public Health Emergency exists in Marinette County.

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution be forwarded to Governor Tony
21 Evers, State Representatives Mursau and Nygren, and State Senator Hansen.

22 Hereby granted this 26th day of May, 2020 by a majority of a quorum of the Marinette
23 County Board of Supervisors.
