RESOLUTION NO.: 106—2020-21

TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

MAJORITY

1 Outagamie County administers the Child Support Enforcement Program on behalf of the
2 state, providing services to over 25,000 Outagamie County residents including paternity
3 establishment, obtaining child support and health insurance orders for children, and
4 enforcing and modifying those orders. Our children's well-being, economic security and
5 success in life are enhanced by parents who provide financial and emotional support.
6 County child support agencies collected \$935 million in child support during 2019 and
7 established 98,405 health insurance orders for Wisconsin children.
8

9 The Outagamie County Child Support Agency provides services to children as well as
10 custodial and non-custodial parents that help reduce childhood poverty rates, establish
11 parental rights and promote the involvement of both parents in the lives of their children.
12 The economic security and social service programs provided by the Outagamie County
13 Child Support Agency are needed by Wisconsin children and families now more than ever
14 due to the economic downturn caused by COVID-19.

16 State funding for county child support services has failed to keep up with county agency
17 costs, which have steadily increased due to growing caseloads, inflation, and new federal
18 regulations. Wisconsin's Child Support Enforcement Program has fallen from second in
19 the nation for collecting current support to fifth. Wisconsin's decreased performance has
20 led to the state losing out on an estimated \$70,000 in potential federal incentive payments
21 between calendar year 2019 and 2020.
22

23 An abrupt federal interpretation change in June 2019 eliminated \$4.2 million in federal
24 birth cost recovery matching funds for Wisconsin. Wisconsin's strong performance in
25 child support is at risk without additional state funding. Further drops in performance
26 would result in additional reductions to federal funding for Wisconsin. Decreased federal
27 funding results in less funding for Outagamie County's Child Support agency. This could
28 lead to reductions in child support enforcement staff and services and reduced child support
29 collections. New state investments in child support are amplified by a general federal
30 match. Every dollar of state General Purpose Revenues (GPR's) invested in the Child
31 Support Program generates roughly two dollars in federal matching funds. Wisconsin's
32 Child Support Enforcement Program is incredibly cost-effective, collecting an average of
33 \$6.20 in support for every dollar invested in the program.

35 NOW THEREFORE, the following resolution is presented by the Health and Human Services

36 Committee to the County Board.

1 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors respectfully requests that
2 state funding for county child support agencies be increased by \$4 million General Purpose Revenues
3 (GPR's) in each fiscal year of the 2021-2023 Wisconsin state budget, which will generate approximately
4 \$7.7 million in additional federal funding each year, such investment to ensure that Wisconsin counties
5 can continue to effectively provide economic support to our children, and

6 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to forward a copy of
7 this resolution to the Wisconsin Counties Association, the Outagamie County Lobbyist for distribution to
8 the State Senators and State Representatives representing Outagamie County, the State of Wisconsin
9 Governor, and the Secretary of the Wisconsin Department of Administration.
