RESOLUTION NO.: 108—2020-21

TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

MAJORITY

1 Per Wisconsin Statute 45.82(2), counties in Wisconsin are eligible to apply for grants to
2 support the work of County Veterans Service Officers (CVSO) and their staff, who work
3 with veterans to obtain benefits earned by virtue of their service to our country. Pursuant
4 to statute and based on county population, Outagamie County (population in excess of
5 75,000) is eligible for a grant of \$13,000. The level of state grant support detailed in
6 statute for these services has not been adjusted in more than two decades.
7

8 The 2021 adopted budget for Outagamie County allocates more than \$426,000 in county
9 levy to defray expenses for the mandated services of the CVSO. This funding supports
10 six full-time equivalent staff positions that serve 11,176 Outagamie County veterans. The
11 county recognizes the importance of the CVSO based on prior year activity levels. For
12 example, in 2019 the Outagamie CVSO helped Outagamie County veterans access over
13 \$5.1 million in federal and state benefits. These dollars circulate in our local economy
14 and reduce the burden on other government and non-profit services.

16 Based on current funding levels, the state grant of \$13,000 constitutes less than 3% of the
17 total funding for the Outagamie CVSO in 2021. Since the CVSO is mandated by the State
18 of Wisconsin, the State should recognize that the allocation has not increased in over 20
19 years.

21 NOW THEREFORE, the following resolution is presented by the Health and Human Services
22 Committee to the County Board.

23 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does encourage the
24 Wisconsin Governor and State Legislature to work together to amend Wisconsin State Statute 45.82(2)
25 and double the annual County Veterans Service Office grant allocation to all counties and tribal
26 organizations, and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does request
28 that funding levels for Veterans Service Offices be evaluated during each biennial budget in order to
29 ensure that state support for this important service to our veterans is maintained, and

1 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to forward a copy of
2 this resolution to the Wisconsin Counties Association, the Outagamie County Lobbyist for distribution to
3 the State Senators and State Representatives representing Outagamie County, and the State of Wisconsin
4 Governor.
