## 2020 RESOLUTION 62

## Advisory Resolution Supporting Election Reform State and Local Level of Government

WHEREAS, continual challenges have repeatedly emerged in national, state and local elections causing an erosion of confidence in our election system and democratic process; and

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2021, Washington County Clerk Ashley Reichert gave a presentation to the Executive Committee to address concerns related to the 2020 Presidential Election which included a discussion of the voting system; and which was attended by clerks and administrators from municipalities across Washington County; and

WHEREAS, committee members, County Executive Schoemann, County Clerk Reichert and clerks and administrators from municipalities located across the County who were in attendance determined the following areas to be in need of reform: 1) processing of mail-in ballots; 2) voter roll purge; 3) definition of "indefinitely confined" for purposes of absentee voting; 4) accepting of ballots in public parks; 5) election administration accountability by the Secretary of State; 6) accuracy of hand count vs. machines; and 7) private entity contributions to election administration;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Washington County Board of Supervisors that this Board hereby supports reforms aimed at restoring integrity in the election process by addressing the pressing areas of concern identified during the course of the February 24, 2021 meeting.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Board herby directs the Washington County Clerk to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Wisconsin Counties Association, and all state senators and assembly members representing Washington County constituents.

## VOTE REQUIREMENT FOR PASSAGE: Majority

RESOLUTION SUMMARY: Advisory resolution supporting reform in the election process by focusing in on six areas: mail-in ballots, voter roll purge, those truly indefinitely confined, accepting of ballots other than clerk office and polling places, Secretary of State role in election administration, hand count vs. machines.
