RESOLUTION NO.: 137—2022-23

TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

MAJORITY

1 The criminal justice system is a core constitutional responsibility of the State of Wisconsin
2 with key services provided by the State Public Defender’s Office, District Attorneys, the
3 Department of Justice, and the judiciary. Although each of these offices have different
4 fundamental roles and responsibilities, they are interrelated such that if one part of the
5 system is under-resourced or inefficient, it impacts all others. Adequate resources for this
6 constitutional service are necessary to protect constitutional rights and to protect public
7 safety. Outagamie County is a critical partner with the state, providing resources, staffing,
8 and infrastructure through the county jail, Sheriff’s Office, Health and Human Services,
9 and staff in the District Attorney’s Office.

10 The State Public Defender’s Office, District Attorneys, the Department of Justice, and the
11 judiciary have collaborated to offer a thorough review of the investments that are critical
12 to ensure Wisconsin meets its constitutional obligations to all citizens impacted by the
13 justice system. Without these resources, Outagamie County will face increased fiscal
14 pressure to continue to provide these critical services using county resources or there will
15 be additional threats to public safety and welfare.

16 Over the last several years, especially due to the pandemic, there has been a significant
17 increase in the workload. Currently, the county funds four prosecutor positions to assist
18 with current caseloads, backlog and the high volume of referrals in Outagamie County.

19 NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Public Safety Committee and the
20 Legislative/Audit and Human Resources Committee recommend adoption of the following resolution.
21

22 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors hereby requests the
23 Governor and the State Legislature fully support the 2023-2025 Biennial Budget requests proposed by the
24 State Public Defender’s Office, District Attorneys, the Department of Justice, and the judiciary to provide
25 critical support to our state’s criminal justice system services, and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors hereby requests
28 the Governor and the State Legislature fully support an increase in the number of Full Time Equivalent
29 positions in District Attorney offices in the State of Wisconsin which is necessary to address the workload
30 impact of direct representation requirements, and

1 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to forward a copy of
2 this resolution to Wisconsin State Public Defender Kelli Thompson, Wisconsin District Attorney's
3 Association President Eric Toney, the Director of State Courts, Attorney General Josh Kaul, State
4 Prosecutors Office Director Kasey Deiss, the Wisconsin Counties Association and the Outagamie County
5 Lobbyist for distribution to the State Senator and State Representatives representing Outagamie County
6 and the Governor of the State of Wisconsin.


