1           **WHEREAS**, on January 25, 2023, the nonpartisan Legislative Fiscal  
2 Bureau reports the State of Wisconsin has a budget surplus estimated of  
3 \$7.1 billion, which is the largest budget surplus in Wisconsin's history; and

5           **WHEREAS**, the Joint Committee on Finance established the Local  
6 Supplemental Transportation Program as a one-time use of State revenue  
7 surplus to support local projects, which evolved into the popular and  
8 successful Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) and Local Road  
9 Improvement Program – Supplemental (LRIP-S); and

11           **WHEREAS**, Governor Evers and the Legislature have recently  
12 devoted additional funding to counties through the General Transportation  
13 Aids (GTA) program and LRIP-S, yet counties throughout Wisconsin are  
14 still not receiving appropriate financial support to make roads and bridges  
15 safe for the speeds and weight of travel experienced through the State.

17           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, That the Door County Board  
18 of Supervisors, in an effort to assist the Wisconsin Counties Highway  
19 Association and the Wisconsin Counties Association, approve the request  
20 of additional funding through budgetary surplus with said funding allocated  
21 to the county GTA appropriation for the backlog of maintenance on the  
22 county trunk highway system, as well as for LRIP-S.

24           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this resolution be sent to  
25 Governor Tony Evers, all members of the State Legislature representing  
26 Door County, the Wisconsin Counties Association, and all other Wisconsin  
27 Counties.
