






 Record and tax parcel data







2023 Wisconsin Act 235 - Judicial Officer Privacy

WLIA Judicial Privacy Task Force

• How to implement shielding requirements

- What additional legislation can be adopted to:
 - Limit the scope of effort for County employees
 - Create more effective legislation



WLIA Legislative Priorities - 2024

Wisconsin Document Recording Fee and the Wisconsin Land Information Program

- AB915 Bill to increase the fee from \$30 to \$45 and increase grant funding to counties
 - Fee has not been updated since 2010
 - The Land Info/GIS industry has seen incredible growth since the last increase
- Did not pass through committee


 Effort is on-going to provide a much needed stimulus to the WLIP




Unprecedented Revenue Trend in 2023-2024

30-year annual average of 1,274,034 documents recorded per year.

This equals \$8,918,238 in Land Information Fund revenue (at \$7 submitted per document recorded).

Due in large part to the increase mortgage interest rates and a limited supply of housing on the market in 2023, the register of deeds recordings declined to the lowest point in 30 years.
