# Resolution in Support of Reauthorization of State Funding for Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program

#### TO THE DOOR COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

**WHEREAS**, The Wisconsin Legislature created the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program in 1989 to preserve valuable natural areas and wildlife habitat, protect water quality and fisheries, and expand opportunities for outdoor recreation; and

**WHEREAS**, It is a mission and strategic priority of the Door County Government to protect the environment of Door County, including its natural resources, especially water quality; and

WHEREAS, The Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program is currently funded through June of 2026 and is up for renewal in 2025. The program has supported land acquisition and capital development by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR), local governments, and nonprofit conservation organizations to preserve valuable natural areas, wildlife habitat, water quality, and outdoor recreation for public benefit around the state; and

**WHEREAS**, The County of Door has benefited over the years having received Stewardship grant funds that have been used to develop trails, parks, and other public outdoor recreation opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, The County of Door considers the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program a valuable tool to preserve and restore natural areas, wildlife habitat, and water quality while supporting the development of public nature-based outdoor recreation opportunities that promote economic development and enhance quality of life; and

**WHEREAS**, It is the intent of the Door County Board of Supervisors to express to our State Legislators and the Governor, the County of Door's support of the reauthorization of the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program in 2025 with sufficient funding allocated to fund projects over the next 10 years.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, That the Door County Board of Supervisors does hereby express to the Wisconsin Legislature and Governor the County of Door's full support for the reauthorization of the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program and request that sufficient funding be allocated to support projects over the next ten year period.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the offices of each of our elected State Legislators and the Office of the Governor.
