RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE STATE DIGITAL EQUITY CAPACITY GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, funding for the State Digital Equity Capacity Grant Program established by the National Telecommunications and Information Administration and administered by the Wisconsin Public Service Commission was terminated on May 9, 2025 in the middle of an open grant application period; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the State Digital Equity Capacity Grant program was to promote internet adoption and digital skills by deploying internet enabled devices and providing digital navigation and digital literacy services to target populations; and

WHEREAS, target populations include low-income individuals, veterans, individuals with disabilities, individuals with language barriers, individuals who are members of racial or ethnic minority groups, incarcerated individuals, or individuals who reside in rural areas; and

WHEREAS, a significant portion of the County's population includes target populations eligible for internet enabled devices and digital navigation services to access the internet for work, education, and health monitoring; and

WHEREAS, local governments and non-profit organizations were coordinating with Great Rivers United Way to submit a grant proposal for up to \$950,000 in funding to form a Digital Opportunity Coalition to serve Monroe County and Jackson County by establishing Digital Navigator positions at Workforce Connections and utilizing the Winding Rivers Library System and Western Technical Colleges to provide digital navigation services; and

 WHEREAS, the termination of the State Digital Equity Capacity Grant Program affects the residents of Monroe County by limiting access to essential services provide by the internet; hindering digital literacy to utilize the internet and internet enabled devices effectively; and deepening the digital divide for rural populations; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Monroe County Board of Supervisors supports the goals of the State Digital Equity Capacity Grant Program and the Wisconsin Public Service Commission and asks for the funding for this program to be re-allocated to the state of Wisconsin;
