## RESOLUTION # 2025-70

## RESOLUTION URGING WISCONSIN LEGISLATORS TO RESTORE CONTINUOUS EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Performance Grant funding is the foundation for local emergency management by funding critical staff, planning, training, exercises, outreach and preparedness activities; and

WHEREAS, without the Emergency Management Performance Grant funding Washburn County's budget cannot absorb the cost of the critical staff, planning, training, exercises, outreach and preparedness activities related to emergency management; and

WHEREAS, as currently written, the current Emergency Management Performance Grant award will result in no EMPG funding for local and tribal programs during the months of January 1, 2025, through September 2025, which is different than what was originally outlined in the Notice of Funding Opportunity for the grant; and

WHEREAS, the loss of Emergency Management Performance Grant funding will have a direct and severe impact on Washburn County's ability to sustain core emergency management functions that keep the County's residents safe and prepared, leaving Washburn County to fill the funding gap on its own; and

WHEREAS, the loss of Emergency Management Performance Grant funding will have a direct and severe impact on Washburn County's ability to respond effectively to disasters and emergencies, and protect lives and property; and

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Washburn County Board of Supervisors asks for the support of state and federal legislators to help bring this issue forward to ensure continuous Emergency Management Performance Grant funding is restored to match the Original Notice of Funding Opportunity and provide funds for the full 2025 calendar year.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall be effective upon its passage and publication and a copy be sent to all Wisconsin State and Federal Legislators representing Washburn County.
