RESOLUTION #28-26
MULTI-STATE INFORMATION SHARING AND ANALYSIS
CENTER STATEWIDE
FUNDING SUPPORTED

PRESENTED BY THE ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Multi-State Information Sharing and Analysis Center (MS-ISAC) provides vital cybersecurity services, including 24/7 threat monitoring and incident response to more than 18,000 state, local, tribal and territorial (SLTT) government organizations supporting our nation's critical infrastructure including public hospitals, public utilities, K-12 school, and law enforcement, and

WHEREAS, local governments, especially in rural and under-resources areas, have relied heavily on MS-ISAC's services, and

WHEREAS, without MS-ISAC services, government organizations are increasingly vulnerable to cyber attacks by foreign adversaries, and

WHEREAS, recent federal funding cuts to MS-ISAC have significantly weakened the nations' defense against cyber threats, and

WHEREAS, Douglas County is currently enrolled in the no-cost membership of MS-ISAC, and

WHEREAS, a paid membership affords additional resources and guidance of the utmost importance to protect against vulnerabilities, and

WHEREAS, all counties in the State of Wisconsin would benefit from the paid membership resources provided through MS-ISAC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Douglas County Board of Supervisors encourages the State of Wisconsin to establish membership to the MS-ISAC for paid membership services to benefit all counties in the state.
